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To: ALL WIA YOUTH PROVIDERS

The purpose of this Directive is to forward final Program Year 2002-2003 performance reports that will be presented at the Youth Council meeting on January 8, 2004. These reports include data that was entered into the Job Training Automation (JTA) system prior to September 20, 2003. As indicated in Los Angeles County WIA Youth Program Directive YTH-D-03-08, subcontractors had the opportunity until September 20, 2003 to enter/correct all client performance data for the performance period of July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003. These resulting final performance figures will be used by the Youth Council to sanction youth providers who fail to meet the performance standards.

The performance numbers on the attached chart were calculated by the State of California's JTA system. LA County MIS staff used the "Print Local WIA Performance Detail Report" screen (PLWPD) to calculate performance of each sub-contractor. County staff suggests that the subcontractor's MIS staff run this report quarterly in order to track agency performance. In addition, County staff also suggests that each sub-contractor run the report entitled "Print Local WIA Performance Roster" (PLWRS) for the periods of 7/02 to 6/03 to determine which clients are actually being included in the performance measures. In order to run an accurate report, staff must enter the agency codes assigned to each youth client track in the agency code field for these reports. In order to do so, you must enter each agency code separated by the "pipe" key. For instance, agency "999" would need to enter "999A|999B|999C" in the agency code field.

These final figures will be presented to the Youth Council on January 8, 2004. Recommendations for probation will be made at that time. Please refer to the Youth Council sanction/performance policy for additional information regarding probation and sanction procedures.
