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To: ALL WIA SERVICE PROVIDERS

The purpose of this Directive is to forward preliminary fourth quarter performance reports that were produced by LA County MIS Staff on July 21, 2005. These reports include data that was entered into the Job Training Automation (JTA) system prior to July 20, 2005 for the performance period beginning July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005. As indicated in EDD Bulletin WIAB05-4, all client data for the performance period of July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005 must be entered into the system for inclusion in final performance prior to **August 5, 2005**. On the morning of August 5, 2005 County MIS staff will begin running the required State reports, therefore, only data entered before this date will be included in FY 2004-2005 final performance for all sub-contractors.

The performance numbers on the attached chart were calculated by the JTA system. Staff of the Los Angeles County WIB used the "Print Local WIA Performance Detail Report" (PLWPD) in order to calculate performance of each sub-contractor. County staff suggests that MIS staff at each sub-contractor run this report quarterly in order to track agency performance. In addition, County staff also suggests that each sub-contractor run the report entitled "Print Local WIA Performance Roster" (PLWRS) to determine which clients are actually being included in the performance measures in the attached chart. Although the 2004-2005 Fiscal Year was the first year of WIA where the County no longer uses the "Track" system, some of the clients who are included in performance will still be identified by tracks. Therefore, in order to run an accurate report, agency staff must enter the agency codes assigned to each youth client track in the agency code field for these reports. MIS staff must enter each agency code separated by the "pipe" key. For instance, agency "999" would need to enter "999|999A|999B|999C" in the agency code field. Please refer to the attached screenshot from the JTA system for information regarding what should be entered in each field of the report set-up screen.

\* Agency is a new contractor for Fiscal Year 2004-2005, therefore it is highly unlikely that these agencies will have any exiters to include in the DOL performance measures.
