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
To: ALL WIA SERVICE PROVIDERS

The purpose of this Directive is to forward preliminary fourth quarter performance reports that were produced by LA County MIS Staff on June 2, 2004. These reports include data that was entered into the Job Training Automation (JTA) system prior to May 20, 2004 for the performance period beginning July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. As indicated in EDD Bulletin WIAB03-61, all client data for the performance period of July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004 may be entered into the system for inclusion in final performance until July 20, 2004. If there is any client data for PY 2003-2004 that has not been entered in the JTA system, please enter the data before this date. Only data entered by the end of the business day on July 20, 2004 will be included in final performance for sub-contractors.

The performance numbers on the attached chart were calculated by the JTA system. Staff of the Los Angeles County WIB used the "Print Local WIA Performance Detail Report" (PLWPD) in order to calculate performance of each sub-contractor. County staff suggests that MIS staff at each sub-contractor run this report quarterly in order to track agency performance. In addition, County staff also suggests that each sub-contractor run the report entitled "Print Local WIA Performance Roster" (PLWRS) to determine which clients are actually being included in the performance measures in the attached chart. Please refer to the attached screenshot from the JTA system for information regarding what should be entered in each field of the report set-up screen. In addition, keep in mind that grant group "51" is for the Adult clients and grant group "52" is for Dislocated Worker.

Also attached to this Directive is a chart showing the exit cohorts that are included in the performance figures for PY 2003-2004. This chart reflects the changes in the exit cohorts used to calculate performance measures that were put into effect according to Department of Labor TEGL 14-03.
