TO: WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT DISLOCATED WORKER CONTRACTORS

Purpose

The purpose of this directive is to inform Dislocated Worker (DW) contractors of the MIS coding policy for Grant Code 108. This policy pertains to those DW contractors who provide DW participants with Additional Assistance services funded by the ARRA DW 25 Percent Rapid Response (RR) and Additional Assistance (AA) funds.

Background


The Workforce Investment Act allows states to provide funds for RR and AA activities to local areas that experience a high demand for services. These funds are allotted from the WIA Dislocated Worker 25 Percent funding stream. For Fiscal Year 2010-2011, DW contractors received supplemental RR monies to provide AA services to DW participants.

Policy

Effective July 1, 2010, DW contractors that provide AA services to DW participants funded through the 25 Percent RR/AA funds must enroll or co-enroll them in **grant code 108** in the Job Training Automation (JTA) system. This will allow Employment Development Department (EDD) and Los Angeles County to track and account for those participants.
